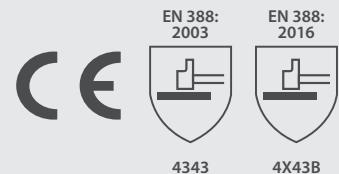

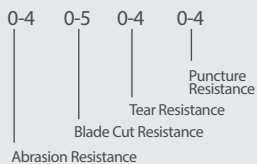
RECOMMENDATIONS FOR USE

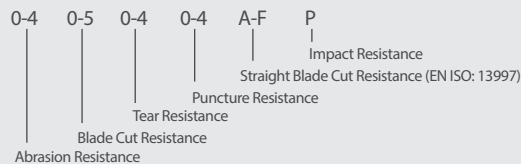
